

Regulations / ENG

The lessons of the **Spoletto Music Academy 2021** masterclass will be held by:

- **Luciana D'Intino** for singing students.
- **Edward Deskur** for horn students

The participants are divided into two categories: active and auditors.

Registrations to participate as an active student will be accepted **until July 15, 2021**. If the number of registered students exceeds the **maximum limit of 10 students** for each masterclass, a selection will be made through the documentation presented (curriculum and video file).

The number of auditor students is unlimited, until the available places are reached in the hall.

Spoletto Music Academy will provide daily tickets for anyone wishing to attend the lessons, in compliance with the health regulations and subject to availability of seats in the hall.

Registration procedure:

Art. 1) Singers and Horn players of all nationalities without age limits can apply to the masterclass.

For admission, all applicants must send an email to the address iscrizioni@spoletomusicacademy.it by July 15, 2021 with the following documents:

- The completed and signed registration form (see link)
- A curriculum vitae
- High-definition photo
- Photocopy of an identity document
- A recent video file or YouTube link with a maximal duration of 10 minutes (mandatory only for active students).

Art. 2) Admission to the masterclass is at the discretion of the teachers and will be communicated by email. Those who are not chosen for active participation will still be able to participate in the masterclass as auditors.

Art. 3) The Association "Visioni d'autore" will process all personal data in compliance with the EU Regulation 2016/679, exclusively for carrying out institutional activities, for the management of the association relationship and for participation in the performances organized by the Association itself.

Art. 4) The masterclass will take place in compliance with the health regulations in force regarding the Covid-19 epidemic.

Deadlines

- The application must be received **by July 15, 2021**
- The non-refundable registration fee of € 50.00 must be received by July 15, 2021.
- For active students the participation fee is:
 - € 550,00 for the singing course
 - € 350,00 for the horn course.
- For auditors the participation fee is:
 - € 100,00 for the singing course
 - € 50,00 for the horn course

Submitting the registration application is equivalent to accepting these regulations in all its parts.

Final concert

Active participants will be required to perform in the final concert to be held on Saturday 7 August 2021 at 7 pm in the fourteenth-century Cloister of San Nicolò, Spoleto.

In case of audio/visual recordings or live streaming of the final concert, no compensation can be paid to the participants. In the same way the participants cannot claim rights to audio/visual recordings taken during the masterclass.

Piano accompanist

Spoletto Music Academy provides a pianist for the entire duration of the singing masterclass. The pianist of the 2021 edition will be Simone Benedetti.

Active students are required to bring **two printed copies** of each piece presented during the masterclass.

Certificates / Scholarships

At the end of the masterclass, all active students will receive a certificate of participation. Scholarships are provided for the most deserving students, whereby the choice is at the exclusive discretion of the teachers.

Hotels, restaurants and transfers

All travel, board and lodging expenses are paid by the students.

Agreements are foreseen with hotels and restaurants in Spoleto; for information please contact the office of the Visioni d'Autore Association.

Masterclass cancellation

In the unlikely event of a failure to reach the minimum number of seven active students, the masterclass will be cancelled. In this case, the participation fee paid by each effective student will be refunded.

The masterclass can also be cancelled if the current health regulations require it.

The Court of Spoleto is competent for any legal dispute.
